



Oizumi-Chuo Park

Information on the Park

Located in the northwestern corner of the Tokyo metropolitan area, the Tokyo Metropolitan Oizumi-Chuo Park offers water facilities, open fields as well as natural forest and plants unique to the Musashino area. The park holds sports facilities including an athletic field and a baseball field. It is also designated as a wide-area evacuation site in the event of a disaster.

Let's Discover

Visitors may find a variety of plants such as ume plum blossoms, Kinmokusei sweet olives, zelkova, cherry blossom (Somei Yoshino, Yamazakura, Uwamizuzakura, Inuzakura), dogwood tree, pink perfection camellia, sawtooth oak, jolcham oak and Japanese flowering dogwood in the park. Enjoy the seasonal greetings from nature with blooming flowers and bearing fruits.

At the park, wild birds like the Japanese bush warbler, warbling white-eye, Japanese pygmy woodpecker, bull-headed shrike, hawfinch, ducks, Japanese tit, starling, brown-eared bulbul, dusky thrush, oriental turtle dove, sparrow and large-billed crow will sing their welcomes. Birdwatching is a great way to spend time at the Wild Bird Forest area. Have fun spotting birds playing in sunny and shaded areas.

Let's Challenge

● Sports ground

Wooden play equipment in the Sports ground encourages children to bond with nature and challenges them to explore. Unity with nature will invite not only children but also adults to enjoy themselves.

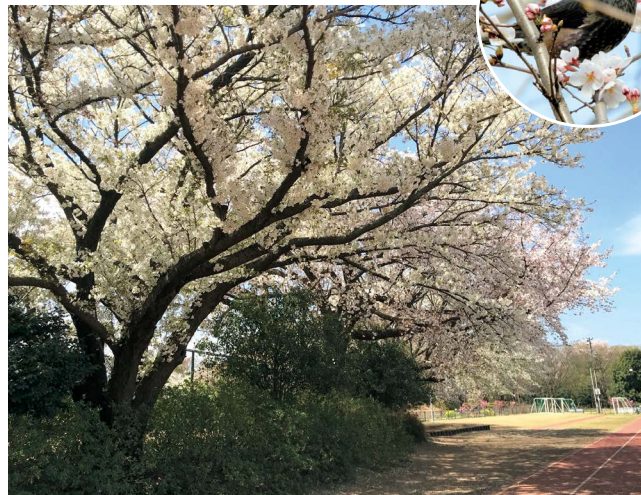
● Baseball field and Athletic field

The park also offers a baseball field with night-time facilities and an athletic field with a 400-meter track. The athletic field is often used for soccer and rugby practice games on weekends and holidays. The field is available for walking and jogging when it is open to the public. For group rental (for a fee) on the baseball and athletic field, please inquire at the Service center.

● Water plaza (only open during the summer)

During the summer, water runs through the fountain, a centerpiece of the Water plaza, making it a favorite place for small children to play. The scene of children enjoying themselves in the water is such a happy sight. It almost eases the heat from the blazing sun.
