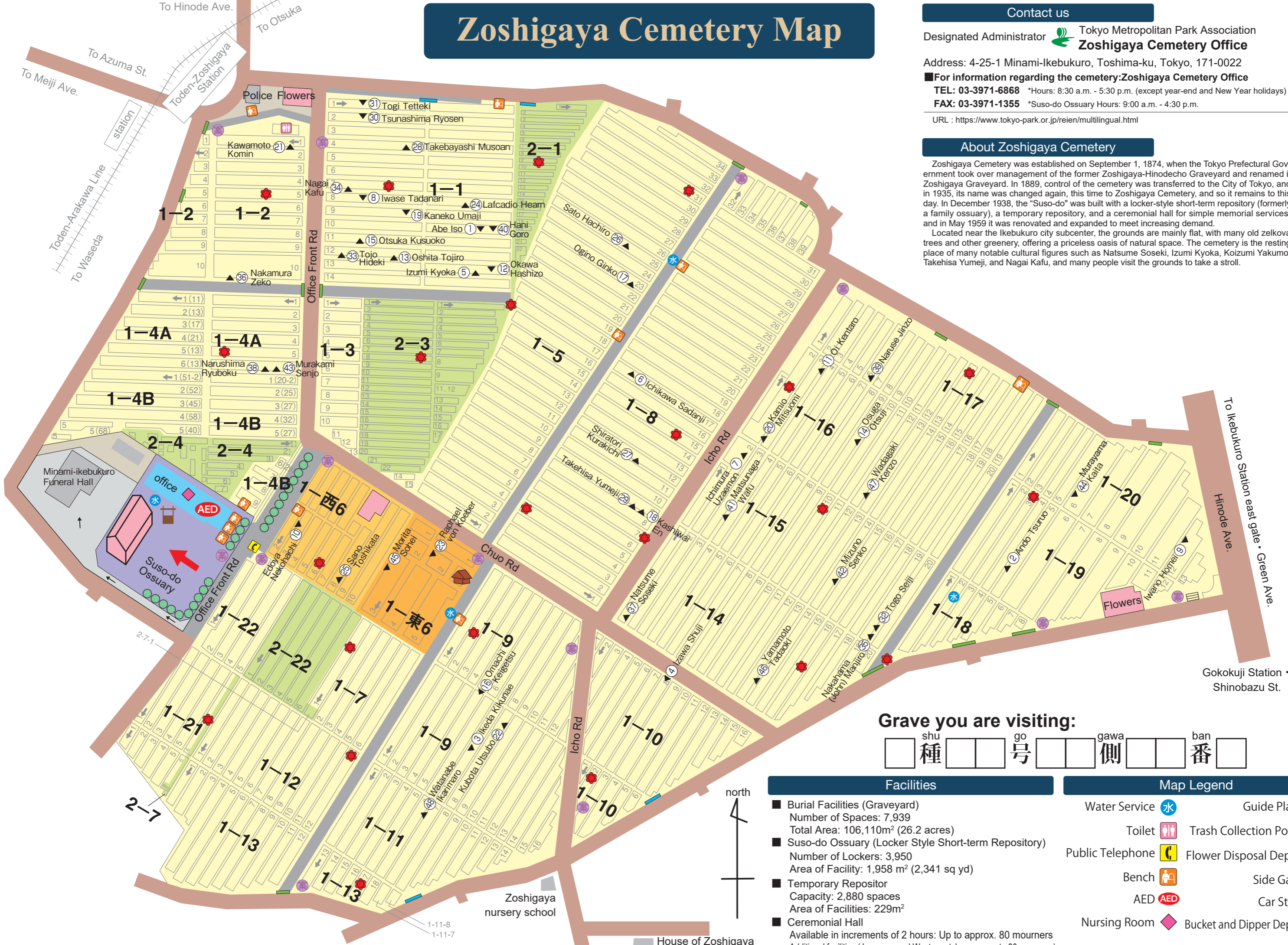

About Zoshigaya Cemetery

Zoshigaya Cemetery was established on September 1, 1874, when the Tokyo Prefectural Government took over management of the former Zoshigaya-Hinodecho Graveyard and renamed it Zoshigaya Graveyard. In 1889, control of the cemetery was transferred to the City of Tokyo, and in 1935, its name was changed again, this time to Zoshigaya Cemetery, and so it remains to this day. In December 1938, the "Suso-do" was built with a locker-style short-term repository (formerly a family ossuary), a temporary repository, and a ceremonial hall for simple memorial services, and in May 1959 it was renovated and expanded to meet increasing demand.

Located near the Ikebukuro city subcenter, the grounds are mainly flat, with many old zelkova trees and other greenery, offering a priceless oasis of natural space. The cemetery is the resting place of many notable cultural figures such as Natsume Soseki, Izumi Kyoka, Koizumi Yakumo, Takehisa Yumeji, and Nagai Kafu, and many people visit the grounds to take a stroll.
